MPD Foundation is a nonprofit organization established in memory of Michael P. Daly. The foundation's purpose is to provide financial assistance to students pursuing curriculum at an accredited University, College, Community College, Vocational or Trade school.

Eligibility

Candidates must be either enrolled as an undergraduate or graduate student in post-secondary education (proof required); a high school senior or adult provisionally accepted to a post-secondary educational institution, Vocational or Trade school, with the intent to further their education/trade skills and/or pursuit of a degree(s). Candidates must have an association with an individual within the roofing and/or sheet metal industry.

Application Requirements

1. A fully completed application
2. A written statement from the educational institution where the undergraduate or graduate work will be undertaken, indicating provisional acceptance of the student at the institution.
3. Official transcripts from current high school or college
4. One letter of recommendation from the person whom you are associated with or connects you specifically to the roofing, sheet metal, or construction industry. No letters of recommendation may come from a director of the MPD Foundation.
5. A typed essay of no more than one page, explaining why the applicant is interested in pursuing a degree or vocation/ trade. Steps that have been taken to pursue this goal including relevant honors, activities, or employment should also be included in the essay.

Optional: Include a brief statement about how the candidate's connection to the roofing and/or sheet metal industry has impacted their life.

Scholarship Awards

The Foundation Board of Directors will determine the number and dollar amount of scholarships awarded by the MPD Foundation.

Award funds are sent directly to the institution for tuition and/or room and board. It is sent for the Spring Semester.

Selection

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of financial need, academic performance, employment experience, relationship to the industry, and/or a demonstrated desire to pursue a degree, continuing education or vocational skills. The applicants selected to receive an award will be notified in writing and email and the award will be mailed to the designated educational institution. All persons, irrespective of race, gender, creed or national origin, who satisfy the eligibility requirements and submit a completed application in a timely manner, will be considered for a scholarship award. The scholarship award will be awarded no later than the start of spring semester to ensure student is in good standing with the educational or vocational / trade institution.

Deadline

Applications, including all required information, must be postmarked no later than June 30, 2022 to be considered for the 2022 - 2023 academic year.
